ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
SARASOTA INSTITUTE OF LIFETIME LEARNING, INC.

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a corporation not for profit under the laws of the State of Florida, hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I

NAME: The name of the corporation is Sarasota Institute of Lifetime Learning, Inc.

ARTICLE II

DURATION: The corporation shall exist perpetually.

ARTICLE III

PURPOSE: The corporation is organized to promote and encourage continuing adult education and for other educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986. No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of any member or other individual.

ARTICLE IV

MEMBERS: The corporation shall have members. The qualifications for members and the manner of their admission shall be as prescribed in the bylaws.

ARTICLE V

BOARD OF DIRECTORS: The corporation shall have twenty-one (21) directors in addition to any past president of the Sarasota Institute of Lifetime Learning, who shall be lifetime members of the Board of Directors at their election. The president of the

corporation shall be chairman of the Board of Directors. The number of directors may be increased or decreased from time to time in accordance with bylaws, but shall never be less than three (3). The names and addresses of the initial directors of the corporation are:

ARTICLE VI

OFFICERS: The affairs of the corporation shall be managed by a president, a vice-president, a secretary, a treasurer, and such other officers and agents as may be deemed necessary and proper as provided for in the bylaws of the corporation. All officers and agents as may be deemed necessary shall be chosen in

such manner, hold their offices for such terms, and have such powers and duties as may be prescribed by the bylaws of the corporation or determined by the Board of Directors. ARTICLE VII

AMENDMENT TO ARTICLES: These Articles of Incorporation may be amended by a vote of two-thirds of the members of the Board of Directors present at any meeting of the Board, provided such amendments are proposed and notice is given in the manner provided in the Bylaws of the corporation.

ARTICLE VIII

DISSOLUTION: In the event of dissolution of the corporation or the winding up of its affairs, all assets of the corporation shall be distributed exclusively to an organization or organizations which then qualify under the provisions of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as it now exists

or may be hereafter amended, and its accompanying regulations as they now exist or as they may be hereafter amended. No member, director, officer or private individual shall be entitled to share in the distribution of any of the corporate assets upon such dissolution.

ARTICLE IX

REGISTERED AGENT: The street address of the initial registered office of the corporation and the name of its initial registered agent at such address are as follows:


